How Inferno Cup Points are Awarded

5 For each player on the winning team for each Set

Possible Bonus Points

- 3 Win a Set by 10+ points
- 2 Win a Set by 6-9 points
- 2 Win a Set in overtime
- 3 Win a Set 25-24
- 2 For each player that sweeps a match 3-0

- 1 for each Ace Serve
- 1 Exceptional Play (very out of the ordinary as determined by the Ref ONLY)
Maximum of 2 of these points can be awarded in any given match. None are required
- 10 Win a Set short handed (play 3 vs 4 and the short handed team wins)

Penalty Points

- 5 Absent for an entire Set (and no sub)
- 3 Late for the start of a Set
- 2 Bad sportsmanship

Each player earns the above points.

The top 2 point earners become captains for the championship match. They will pick their own teams.

Top point earner determines championship format (front row attack vs back row attack)

The winner of the championship match (regardless of Cup Points) becomes the Inferno Cup Champion.

Remember, these are all your teammates. It's good to be competitive, but always be respectful and encouraging
